Colonel Rebekah “Becky” Lust is from Mercer, Pennsylvania. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Speech Communications from Edinboro University of Pennsylvania and was commissioned through the ROTC program into the Adjutant General’s Corps. She is a graduate of the AG Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Army Command and General Staff College, and the Eisenhower School of National Security and Resource Strategy. She attained two Master of Arts degrees from Webster University, one in Human Resources Development and one in Computer Resources and Information Management and a Master of Science degree in National Resource Strategy.

COL Lust currently serves as the Division Director, Functional Management Division (FMD), Integrated Personnel and Pay System - Army, and she served as the FMD Deputy Director from 2021-2023. Prior to graduating from the Eisenhower School she served as the Assistant Chief of Staff, G1 for 25th Infantry Division from June 2018 to June 2020 and Assistant Director, Force Management in the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Manpower and Reserve Affairs, Military Personnel Policy, Officer and Enlisted Personnel Management from June 2016 to June 2018.
