Did You Know?

The FY20 National Defense Authorization Act, Sections 569-570 of Public Law 116-92, directed the Department of Defense to:

- 1) Modify the DD Form 214, "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty," to be machine readable and electronically transferable and include a specific block for Members to provide one or more email addresses for contacting purposes
- 2) Establish and implement a standard record of service for members of the Reserve component

What are We Doing About it?

The <u>DD Form 214/214-1</u> Series is coming to IPPS-A! Members and HR Professionals will be able to access the forms for review, corrections, and more efficient and accurate completion. Development is still underway in the system, but here is a sneak peek to provide instructions, explain changes, and get user feedback.

With the new DD Form 214 integration, Members (**Self-Service**) may review and initiate corrections to their DD Form 214 during the entire transition process.

With the new DD Form 214 integration, **HR Professionals** may review, complete and finalize Members' DD Form 214s ensuring accuracy and decreased processing times.



The DD Form 214-1, "Certificate of Uniformed Service, Reserve Component Addendum," captures all Selected Reserve periods. Army National Guard (ARNG) and U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) Members who separate from their component while in a Reserve status or transfer to Individual Ready Reserve (IRR), will receive the DD Form 214-1 along with the standard DD Form 214.

DD Form 214-1 HR Professional View




With the new DD Form 214-1 integration, HR Professionals may review, complete and finalize Members' DD Form 214-1s ensuring accuracy and decreased processing times.
